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NAG2A (b)(i) Areas of Strength

National Standard area(s): Reading

Discussion: Reading Target - After one Year at School 90% of students will have achieved to Level 12 in READING

By the end of 2017

75% of Year 1 students were At or Above National Standard. This equates to 9 / 12 students.

93% of Year 4 students were At or Above National Standard. This equates to 15 / 16 students.

82% of Year 7 students were At or Above National Standard. This equates to 9 / 11 students.

100% of Year 8 students were At or Above National Standard. This equates to 4 / 4 students.

Our Year 2, 3, and 6 all scored over 60% success rate.

The increase in time allocated to teach Literacy and Numeracy; teacher aide time to assist with these programmes; students assisting other students and the students setting goals and challenging themselves to achieve these goals has all helped in lifting this achievement.

Each teacher identified children 'At Risk' and Inquired into their learning. The impact of each child's intervention was measured.

The School SENCO registered was set up and monitored by the Principal. Each teacher and Teacher Aides met with the Principal twice a term to discuss the impact of recovery programmes and Teacher Inquiry.

NAG2A (b)(i) Areas for Improvement

National Standard area(s): Writing

Discussion: Writing Target –

- 70% of Year 4-8 students in achieving At/Above the NS in WRITING
- 80% of Year 1- 3 students are achieving At/Above the NS in WRITING.

By the end of 2017

50% of Year 2 students were At or Above National Standard. This equates to 4 / 8 students.

44% of Year 4 students were At or Above National Standard. This equates to 7 / 16 students.

- 70% of Year 4-8 students in achieving At/Above the NS in WRITING

End of 2017 - Overall we have 69.2% (63/91 students) of our children working At or Above the National Standard. We have 40% (2/5 students) of our Maori students working At or Above. We have 100% (1/1) of our Pacifica Students working At or Above. We have 78.4% (65/83 students) of our NZ European Students working At or Above.

39 / 55 Year 4 -8 children were At or Above National Standards, 71%

- 80% of Year 1- 3 students are achieving At/Above the NS in WRITING

End of 2017 24 / 35 students were At or Above National Standards, 69%

The target was met and progress has been pleasing but we have identified Writing as an area to target to hopefully achieve greater results.
